This coming Wednesday is the commemoration of All Souls, a day the church honors those who have gone before us in death. The church has always paid great honor and attention to those who have died and, this teaching flows from its concern for all life issues.


At times today the person who becomes responsible for the disposition of the earthly remains of another person may not have a clear understanding of the intentions of the deceased. In some instances the person making the decision is not a close relative or friend and there is no one around who knows the intentions of the deceased.

One way to overcome this is to have in your important papers a document similar to the one on page 4 of the bulletin, which gives specific instructions to be followed at the time of your death. By having such a document you actually alleviate the burden of others because they know exactly what you would want.

I encourage you to read through it and if it is something that you find applicable to your situation to execute it and have it placed with your important documents.

May the souls of the faithful departed rest in peace. Amen.

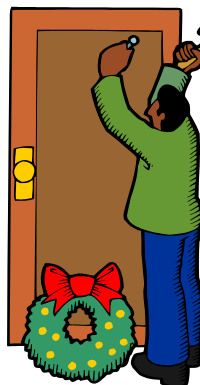
